ENERGY STAR Rated Refrigerators

Thanks to recent improvements in insulation and compressors, today's refrigerators use much less energy than older models. With an **ENERGY STAR** qualified refrigerator, you can maximize your energy and dollar savings without sacrificing the features you want.

Slash your energy bills. **ENERGY STAR** qualified refrigerators are required to use 20% less energy than models not labeled with the **ENERGY STAR** logo. Choose a new qualified model rather than a non qualified model and cut your energy bills by \$165 over the lifetime of your fridge.

Replace your old fridge for bigger savings. If you still have a fridge from the 1980s, replace it with an **ENERGY STAR** qualified model and save over \$100 each year on your utility bills. Replace a fridge from the 1970s and save more than \$200 each year!

Protect the environment. Nearly 70% of U.S. electricity is generated with coal and natural gas, which release greenhouse gasses into the atmosphere and contribute to climate change. **ENERGY STAR** qualified refrigerators use less energy and help us reduce our impact on the environment.
