What Is STEP And How Can It Help Me?

What is STEP?

Our Goal is to empower Tribal members with the ability to maintain healthier, more livable homes, control their utility costs, and conserve natural resources.

We plan to reach these goals by providing education and assistance for tribal members about energy conservation, home weatherization and reducing waste generated. We will also explore renewable energy options for tribal administration buildings, homes and businesses.

Over the next two years we will be working to develop green building codes for the tribe, requirements for energy efficient appliances and equipment. We will also develop a five year strategic plan which will include a plan to sustain the program after the current grant money is spent.

The Siletz Tribal Energy Project (STEP) is funded by grant money from the Administration for Native Americans, Recovery Act money from the Department of Energy and money from the Bonneville Power Administration.

Who can take advantage of the STEP program?

If you are an enrolled Siletz tribal member or have one living in your household, we can assist you in some way. It does not matter what your income level is, although we are able to provide more services to those with lower incomes.

Do you need an energy audit on your home, does your home need to be weatherized? We can assist with that. If you are over income we can provide you with a free energy audit and suggestions on things you can do improve your home yourself. If you are under income, we can provide you with a free energy audit and some free weatherization work on your home. Once work is complete, you should be more comfortable, healthier, and your utility bills may decrease.



Everyone is welcome at our public events such as Earth Day, Pow Wow, and educational seminars we may have.
