Siletz Tribe Receives \$1 Million Grant for Water Storage Tank and Waterline

The Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians is proud to announce being the recipient of a \$1 million federal grant from the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Rural Development program.

The grant will enable the Tribe to construct a new water storage tank and waterline in the Siletz area.

The Tribe plans to provide water lines and sewers for two area properties known as the Dundas property and the Grooms property on the southeast side of the city. Plans for the Dundas property call for the development of an industrial park. The Grooms property would be developed into additional governmental services buildings or Tribal housing.

The Tribe is working with the City of Siletz to connect all lines and make sure everyone benefits from the installation of modern water lines and storage facilities.

The project will be constructed in three phases. Phase one calls for the construction of a new 500,000-gallon water storage tank. New water and sewer lines for the Dundas property will be the second phase and the third phase of the project will be the facilities for the Grooms property.

The overall cost of the project is \$1,351,650 and the Tribe will cover the additional \$351,650 to complete the project.
