

How do I sign up?

1. Complete a Weatherization Application, with Weatherization Services Agreement (on back of application) signed by the owner of the house or mobile home.
2. Include Proof of Income for the most recent 2 months for all adults (over 18) in the household. If you received LIHEAP (energy assistance) during the past year, you automatically qualify and do not have to send in income documents.
3. If you know you are over income and just want an audit and education, check the box that says over income. You do not need to attach income documentation.

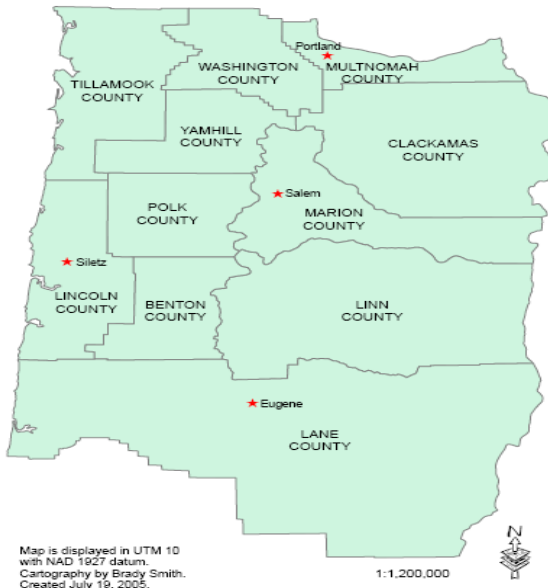
What counts as income and how do I document it?

- Wages: send copy of wage stubs for the most recent 2 months.
- Social Security, Assistance, Pensions, Annuities, unemployment, or other fixed income: send copy of benefit letter, checks for the last 2 months, or a recent bank statement (if direct deposit).
- Child Support: send copy of checks for the most recent 2 months
- Rental Income: provide documents showing income.
- If you have NO INCOME: provide a signed, dated statement from the adults with no income stating, "I have no income at this time and _____ pays my bills."

Where can I apply?

You can simply pick up an application at our office located at 107 SE Swan Ave. ("old clinic") or you can have an application mailed directly to you by calling our office!

What Is Weatherization And How Does It Help Me?

What is Weatherization?

Weatherization is making a house or other building secure against cold or stormy weather.

Weatherization measures help reduce energy bills by making homes more energy efficient and *may include:*

- **diagnostic testing*
- * *attic insulation*
- * *wall insulation*
- * *weather stripping*
- * *caulking*
- * *furnace inspections*
- * *duct sealing*
- * *minor repairs*
- * *CFL's*

Regardless of income level, the STEP Team *may* audit your home free of charge and provide valuable education on keeping your home safe and warm.

Our weatherization program is funded by federal and state grants as well as local utility companies.

Who is eligible for Low Income Weatherization Services?

Enrolled tribal members who rent or own their home and with income that falls below these guidelines:

What are the benefits of Weatherizing my home?

Weatherization makes you more comfortable by keeping your home warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer.

We know that everyone's home is different, but it is possible for a typical household to save \$300 or more a year in energy costs by weatherizing their home.

While our program focuses on low-income tribal members, you may qualify for a *free* home energy audit and technical assistance, regardless of your income level.

Our professional energy team has been trained and certified by the State of Oregon to run diagnostic tests on your home. These tests are invaluable tools that educate home owners and residents about home energy use, energy loss and possible savings.
