

## **477-Self Sufficiency Program**

### **Emergency Assistance for Tribal Members**

The 477-SSP has services available for those that have been impacted by the Oregon fires. If resided in the CTSI Service Area and under a level 2 or 3 evacuation, and below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level, you may qualify for services. Eligibility is based on household and not individual Tribal members.

<p><b><u>Eligibility:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Level 2 evacuation: Up to \$1,000</li><li>• Level 3 evacuation: Up to \$2,000</li><li>• Damaged or complete loss of home: Up to \$3,000</li></ul>	<p><b><u>Services may include:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Food</li><li>• Clothing</li><li>• Basic household items</li><li>• Personal sanitation items</li><li>• Transportation assistance</li><li>• Deposits/ Move in costs</li></ul>
