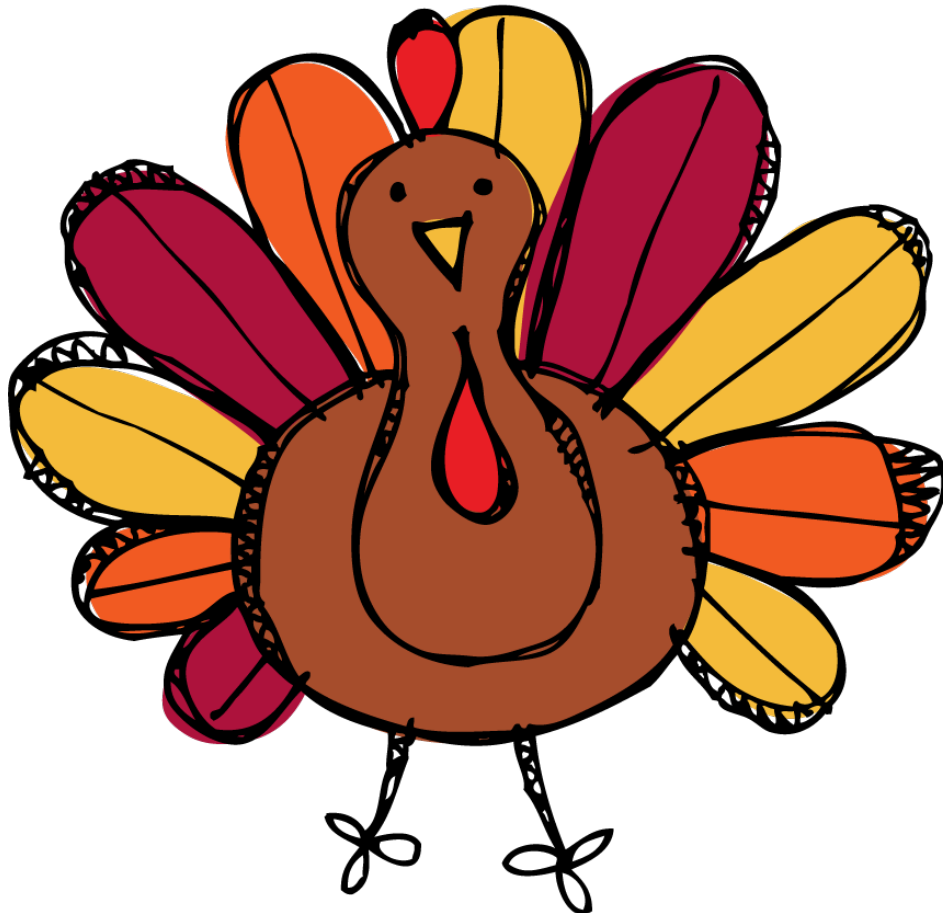

## Twice Baked Potato Casserole With Bacon

### Ingredients:

- 2 large baking potatoes
- ½ pound lean bacon
- ¾ cup shredded mild cheddar cheese
- ½ cup sour cream
- ¼ cup milk
- 2 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted
- 1 teaspoon dried chives
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon ground black pepper
- ½ teaspoon garlic powder
- ¾ cup shredded mild cheddar cheese



### Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Grease a 9x13 inch casserole dish.
2. Poke a few holes into each potato using a toothpick.
3. Bake potatoes in the preheated oven until fully cooked, about 1 hour. Cool for about 15 minutes.
4. Place the bacon in a large skillet and cook over medium-high heat, turning occasionally, until evenly browned, about 10 minutes. Drain the bacon slices on paper towels and crumble.
5. Cut a thin slice from one side of each potato; carefully scoop out the flesh and transfer to a bowl. Discard skins. Mix ¾ cup cheddar cheese, sour cream, milk, butter, chives, salt, black pepper, and garlic powder with the potatoes. Spread potato mixture into the prepared casserole dish; top with ¾ cup cheddar cheese and crumbled bacon.
6. Bake in the preheated oven until just bubbling, 10 to 15 minutes. Cool for at least 5 minutes before serving.
7. Makes 4 servings.
