Student Laptop Program

The Central Administration office will accept applications for the Student Laptop Program beginning Aug. 1, 2017. Early applications will not be accepted.

This program is specifically for higher education and AVT students who meet the following eligibility requirements and have not previously received a student laptop:

- ✓ Must be an enrolled Siletz Tribal member
- ✓ Must provide copy of current term class schedule of six credit hours or more
- ✓ Must provide an unofficial transcript/grade report of successful completion of two consecutive quarters/semesters (six credit hours or more) of higher education/AVT program with a minimum 2.0 GPA
- ✓ Proof of residence required.

Second Cut Wood for the Elders Day

The Tribal Natural Resources Committee and Natural Resources Department will sponsor the second Cut Wood for the Elders Day of the year on July 15.

The woodcut will be held on the Tribe's Logsdon Road property between the Tribal food distribution warehouse and the Tribal vehicle storage yard in Siletz.

We need lots of volunteers to help cut, split and deliver firewood for Tribal elders. Bring your chainsaws, hydraulic wood splitters, splitting mauls, axes and lots of energy.

Lunch, drinks and snacks will be provided. We will start at 8 a.m. and go until around 2 p.m.

The goal of this event will be to deliver firewood to as many elders as possible. The Elders Program maintains a list of elders who burn wood for their winter heat.

People willing to haul firewood to elders outside of the Siletz area should contact the Elders Program clerk at 800-922-1399, ext. 1261, or 541-444-8261 to be paired up with an elder in need. We especially need folks who can haul wood to the Eugene, Salem and Portland areas.

Elders in need of firewood also should contact the Elders Program clerk to get their name on the delivery list.

The first woodcut held in May was immensely successful. Let's see if we can repeat that success at this one. If you have parents or grandparents who burn wood in the winter to stay warm, you need to help out at this event!

Be sure to mark your calendars for the final woodcut of the year that will be held Sept. 16.

Attention Youth Elk Hunters

Tribal Natural Resources is now accepting applications for the Siletz Tribal youth antlerless elk tag drawing. The form is posted on the Tribal website (ctsi.nsn.us) and also can be picked up at the Natural Resources office.

Youth must be 12-17 years old by Aug. 1, 2017, and must have completed an Oregon Hunters Safety course prior to the drawing to be held on July 10, 2017. A hunters safety number must be provided.

One youth antlerless elk tag will be issued for Stott Mt. and Alsea units.

Applications are due to the Natural Resources Department by 4:30 p.m. on July 7, 2017. Contact Natural Resources if you have any questions, 541-444-8227.

Fresh Steelhead Calling

During July and August, we receive whole-bodied hatchery steelhead from ODFW's Siletz Falls fish trap for distribution to Siletz Tribal families. If you would like to subscribe to the auto-dial message system to receive a recorded call on the day steelhead will be available, please call the Natural Resources Department at 541-444-8227.

Usually, we receive 1-2 hours advance notice on the day fish will be available, but lead time varies. The pickup site is at the Tribal administration building on Southeast Swan Avenue in Siletz.

We ask everyone to bring their Tribal ID and to come in person to pick up fish, which are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis (notes are not accepted).
