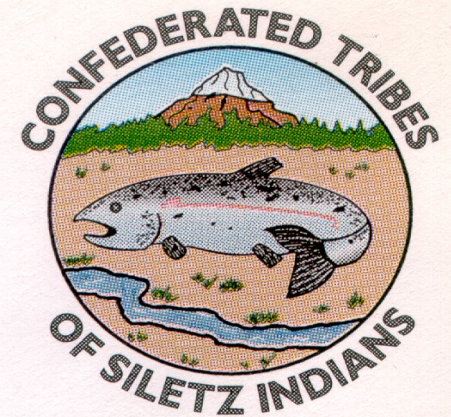

WHAT IS LIHEAP?

- LIHEAP (Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program) is a Federally-funded program that helps low-income households with their home energy bills.
- LIHEAP can help you stay warm in the winter. By doing so, you can reduce the risk of health and safety problems (such as illness, fire, or eviction.)

WHAT ASSISTANCE DOES LIHEAP PROVIDE?

- ◆ Bill payment assistance.
- ◆ Crisis assistance.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Individuals who meet the below requirements are eligible for bill payment or crisis assistance:

Enrolled Siletz Tribal Member

The applicant, or a child residing in the household, must be an enrolled Siletz tribal member.

Residence Location

The residence must be located within the II county service area.

Income Eligible

The applicant must meet the annual income guidelines established in the benefit matrix, as abbreviated below:

<u>Household Size</u>	<u>Annual Income</u>
1	\$21,070
2	\$28,386
3	\$35,065
4	\$41,744
5	\$48,423

WHEN CAN I APPLY?

October 1st—Siletz Tribal Elders and Disabled Tribal Members

November 6st—Other Eligible Siletz Tribal Households

WHAT INFORMATION DO I NEED TO APPLY?

To participate in the program you must submit the following:

1. **Application** (In-take should be done in a tribal office, unless other arrangement are made.)
2. **Tribal identification** card or **CIB**
3. **Social Security cards REQUIRED** for all persons living in your household. These must be presented at time of in-take.
4. **Recent utility bills** (the individual named on the utility bill **must** be included in the household composition.)
5. Disconnect or Shut off notice (if you've received a notice from your utility company.)
6. **Documents verifying the income** of every household member aged 18 years and above, such as:
 - ◆ A recent payroll stub or other proof that shows the current gross income.
 - ◆ Documentation, such as an award letter, showing income from Social Security, Unemployment Insurance, Pension Funds, disability, etc.
